GAANN Fellowships in Artificial Intelligence and Cybersecurity for Graduate Students

Through a grant from the U.S. Dept. of Education, the **Graduate Assistance in Areas of National Need (GAANN) Program** provides fellowships to assist excellent graduate students, particularly traditionally underrepresented minority groups including women, pursuing their thesis track M.S. degree in Computer Science (CS) or Data Analytics (DA) with a focus on Artificial Intelligence or Cybersecurity

The GAANN Fellowship will provide:

- Full coverage of tuition and fees for two years (four semesters)
- Annual stipend of up to \$34,000 (based on financial need as determined by FASFA)
- Funding for research equipment, research-related travel expenses, books
