Graduate Teaching Fellowship at the Department of Mathematics

The department of mathematics awards a limited number of teaching fellowships on a competitive basis for students enrolled in the MA in Mathematics with the thesis option. Availability of teaching fellowships may vary each year and is contingent on availability of funds.

Benefits of TA fellows:

- Tuition reduction: TA fellows only have to pay for a reduced tuition (\$1000/semester + fees)
- Stipend: TA fellows will receive a stipend by teaching some recitation sections for the Department of Mathematics. The 2024-2025 stipend is \$15,800 per year.

Responsibility of TA:

In order to maintain the fellowship, the TA fellow must:

- Maintain a full-time status each semester in good standing. Fellowships require four (or fewer) consecutive terms of full-time enrollment. Failure to maintain this status will result in loss the teaching fellowship.
- Actively work on research projects leading to a Master's thesis under the supervision of a faculty member from the department of mathematics.
- Teach 4 recitation sections of a math course each semester and maintain satisfactory performance in teaching.

To apply:

Only graduate students who have been admitted into the MA in Mathematics. in Mathematics program **starting from a fall semester** can apply to the TA fellowship. To apply, send an email with a cover letter to the Mathematics Graduate Coordinator expressing your interest in applying for a teaching fellowship and explaining why you want the fellowship and why you believe you are qualified for it. The GRE General Test and Subject Test in mathematics are strongly recommended for all applicants.

Applications to the TA fellowship will be reviewed by the Mathematics Graduate Program Committee. Decisions will be made in March.

Deadline: The deadline to apply for the TA fellowship is **Mar 01** each year.
