#### Research Experiences

My primary research interests focus on sexual aggression and risky sexual behaviors. I also have secondary interests in PTSD and substance use. I maintain an active research team of graduate and undergraduate students with a focus on laboratory based experimental research examining 1) men's engagement in sexually aggressive behavior, 2) women's risk recognition for sexually inappropriate behaviors, and 3) observer perceptions of sexually aggressive behavior. I have recently developed an alcohol administration laboratory to facilitate the understanding of intoxication as a precursor to sexual decision-making. Finally, I also conduct survey-based research to understand the correlates of sexually aggressive and risky behaviors, as well as factors related to successful substance abuse treatment and twelve-step engagement, such as readiness to change processes.
